

Dedication to Horace W. Diamond

Solution mining sessions on May 26, 1983 were dedicated to the memory of Horace W. Diamond. Horace was deeply involved in the organization of the Brine Cavity Research Group which later became the Solution Mining Research Institute (SMRI). His career in the salt business was first with the Diamond Crystal Salt Company and then for almost 25 years with the Morton Salt Company. After his retirement in 1971 he became Executive Director of the SMRI, and served in this capacity until his death in 1978. He was responsible for much of the growth and development of the SMRI. Horace was a good friend as well as associate of many of us.

Dedication to J. F. (Tup) Gilbert

Tup was very active in the Solution Mining Research Institute (SMRI) during his career with Dow Chemical of Canada (1942-78) and after his retirement in 1978 until his death in 1981.
